Solid Waste Department Policy Concrete Disposal At Regional Landfill

When customers deliver concrete to the Regional Landfill handle it according to the following Policy:

- 1. If the concrete has no wire mesh, reinforcing rod (re-bar), or other non-concrete items in it, charge the customer the demolition tipping fee, and direct them to drop it off in the "clean" concrete pile located north of the appliance storage area.
- 2. If the concrete contains any amount of wire, reinforcing rod, pipe, wood or similar items, charge the customer the demolition tipping fee and have them place it in one of the demolition bins.
- 3. If the concrete pieces are too large, bulky, or heavy to place in the demolition bins, or if the load contains MSW material, charge the customer the MSW tipping fee, and direct the customer to place the concrete into the Regional Landfill working face.
