#### **Meeting Minutes:**

- 1. Call to Order
  - o Jeff Kazel called to order.
- 2. Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting
  - Motion to approve. Linda Bergstrand/seconded by Eric Jankila. Minutes passed.
- 3. Communications
  - o Dewey Johnson- none.
- 4. Unfinished Business
  - ARMER Update

- Lots of changes. County Board yesterday- last of 5 contracts for MNDOT sites. Should be finished up by 22<sup>nd</sup>. Sites finished by end of the year. Cloquet water site- tower up, antennas up. Equipment move over the next couple of weeks.
- Temporary tower on trailer- waiting on contract between MNDOT and MNSCU
- New site Erie Hill and Meander- on Echo Trl, have contractor, started construction on roads. Vermilion Dam site- there is a power issue that will incur some expense
- Lost Lakes site- high cost of power as well
- Argo Lakes site- just finishing final agreement between Cypress Mining and MNDOT
- Maple Hill-extend what's there, put in own building, working with Public Works
- Lakewood Rd area below fire hall to upper McQuade Rd- was no coverage at all. Using existing tower- antennas below roof of fire tower, extended 20 ft- better coverage, but marginal in some areas. Convinced MNDOT to put back on listagreed to 180ft, but not covered.
- 25 to finish- important to get agreements between MNDOT and SLC now so we don't lose funding
  - Dept of Public Safety needs to know there's funding in place and things are left to do
- Capacity increases planned- EOC site needs to be finished
  - Arrowhead- 5 channels to 6
    - Carlton and Cloquet bring in most traffic
  - Sites up north
    - $\circ$  Ran out of frequencies- only have access to 1/3 of frequencies
    - Put in Simulcast- Virginia prime site, 4 of sites are in there (Erie Hill not yet)
- Reprogramming
  - Just ready to start. Spoke with a few fire departments. Fleet Map Committee- agreement LE/fire. Changes in state policy- Interop realignment of statewide zones.
  - Plan to reprogram ours. Everyone liked layout, but changes needed. Need to be tuned. Free upgrade from Motorola- trying to do LE all at once. Fire will be spread out. To the end of next June. Will contact everyone. Gather up radios- come out the day of the Fire Meeting, spend day upgrading.
- Motorola
  - End of life XTL and XTS radios. By end of year. Replacement is Apex. High-level and expense Apex out there. 1000 and 2000 mobiles and portables. Will be available by the end of year. Recommendation – may

want to consider expansion before the end of year. Got 5500 radios put out in field (sent back 20 so far under warranty). Warranty- bought 3-year, got 1.5 years on them left. Responsibility then is to agencies- \$400-500 per radio (depending on model).

# • Dispatch Hiring/Staffing Update

• Completed interviews for PT positions (3). Now added 4<sup>th</sup> with a resignation.

## • Cautions in Shield

 Putting Cautions in Shield. Sheriff's Office has been doing this. Keeping in CAD now- will work well. Lisa Johannessohn will let everyone know when complete.

## o LE Handbook Guidelines

- Response- make sure handbooks get down to troops. Traffic stops (CAD messages)- officer safety.
- Specifics- Duluth guys (doing traffic instead traffic stops).
- Angie Herbert will resend PDF.

## o Iam Responding

- If you are having issues, don't call dispatch. Contact Lisa (or Dewey). Request two email addresses- fire and ems. It is CAD driven, not radio.
- Eric will send out message to Box Alarm Group.

## 5. Report of Officers and Committees

- Fleet Map
  - Can come off the agenda (as per Dewey).
  - Bruce Hegrenes changes? Hasn't heard from anyone else. Dewey- moving admin up to 2<sup>nd</sup> position. Main, then admin. Cleanup statewide zones, areas. Tuning radios at same time. Mobiles and portables on site. Communication from Bruce will be sent out shortly.
  - Fleet map updates- will bring up to Ely.
  - Training- Make sure you train on radios. Some haven't changed zone in a year and a half. When we come in, good time to do training- do half hour training (reacquaint staff).
    - Could do during Box Alarm Meeting- incorporate training.
    - Kurt- typing areas between mobiles and portables
      - Bruce/Dewey- this is getting fixed, will be fixed with reprogramming
    - Bruce note- our guys (radio) are not trainers can do brief informational discussion, but not official training

- COM Plan for Summer Events
  - 3 COM L's Bruce, Jason Matthias, Dewey

- If you have a big event, speak to the above
- COM plan- training, active-shooter event (Duluth)
- Event talk groups- middle of summer, all were in use during 4<sup>th</sup>
  - o If you've got a function- reserve event talk group early
  - One for street dance- will use law 4
- Additional dispatch added for events
- 30 radios in cache- can be requested
  - o SLC 18 fire/ems radio cache
  - LE cache- command vehicle/portable
  - o Let us know in advance if needed
  - Small event- Any dispatcher can reserve- call into dispatch and will let you know what's available
  - Large event- Notify Bruce or Dewey
- Note- whole Airshow will be on ARMER
- Volume of calls
  - DPD- call supervisors on duty- priority calls busy (priority calls should not be held)
  - Steve Steblay sent out message- county-wide, priority call will not held they will be dispatched out or supervisor notified
- o Interoperability- fire/ems/le
  - Traffic-control incidents
  - Radio training- radio communication
  - Dispatch- assigned common- large event/incident
    - Ex- traffic accident
    - Assign on one talk group
